## GUIDED TOURS AND TALKS

### Meeting House Tour **10:15 AM, 2:15 PM**

The 1820 Meeting House is an architectural marvel. This tour examines the Shaker worship service & the unique truss system that supports the building. The second floor houses the Dorothy Norton Clay Collection of original Pleasant Hill Shaker furniture.

### Shaker Life & Beliefs Talk **11:30 AM, 1:30 PM**

**Meet outside the Meeting House.** This informal talk explores the Shakers' religious beliefs & how those beliefs were manifested in their daily lives.

### Centre Family Dwelling Tour **12:15 PM, 3:45 PM**

This 45-minute guided tour explores Shaker family life, furniture & common daily activities within the 40-room hub of the village.

### Shaker Agriculture Talk **3 PM**

**Historic Farm Barn.** The Shakers were Kentucky's premier agriculturalists. This talk looks at the animals, crops & gardens of the 19th century Shakers.

### Solo Performances **11 AM, 1 PM, 3 PM, 4:30 PM**

**Inside the Meeting House.** The Meeting House bell will ring 10 minutes prior to each performance. Shakers shared their devotion through dancing & singing. Today, inspirational solo music performances fill the Meeting House.
