

# TRAIL GUIDELINES



SHAKER VILLAGE  
OF PLEASANT HILL

Thank you for your interest in exploring The Trails of Shaker Village. For your comfort and safety, please review and abide by the below guidelines during your adventures.

- All trail users must check in at The Inn at Shaker Village front desk or ticket booth each day to sign a waiver of liability, pay any appropriate daily usage fee and check out a gate key.
- No dogs allowed on trails.
- Trail parking is in the village and at the West Lot. Horse trailers must park in the designated area near the stables and hikers and bicyclists may park in the West Lot parking lot. The River Road Trail and the 1837 Turnpike Trail begin in the village.
- Trails are open from dawn to dusk.
- No motorized vehicles of any kind are allowed on any trail at Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill.
- Bicycling is permitted on all paved roads and multi-use trails.
- Rock climbing or repelling is not allowed.
- Parts of the Shawnee Run Trail, the Towering Sycamore Trail and the Little Texas Trail are seasonal and may be impassible due to high water.
- Trails travel through protected areas. Do not disturb or collect plants or animals. Do not collect rocks, fossils or remains of human history.
- Trails pass abandoned mine sites. **Warning: Avoid all mine sites. Do not attempt to enter.**
- Observe all posted trail markers - some trails are for hiking only.
- No drinking water or restroom facilities are available on trails. A portable facility is located at the trailhead used by horseback riders.
- Lock all gates behind you, unless gates are already open.
- Hikers and bicyclists yield to equestrians on trails.
- Hunting or possession of any type of firearm or any other deadly weapon on Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill property is specifically prohibited. Inn guests are allowed to fish in the main village pond only.
- Shaker Village does not provide horses or bicycles for trail riding.
- Following all trail use guidelines ensures the continued availability of village property for these activities.
- A gate key drop box is located at the stop sign as you enter the main parking log.
- To protect the scenic beauty of the area, we ask that you follow the familiar saying "If you pack it in, pack it out."
